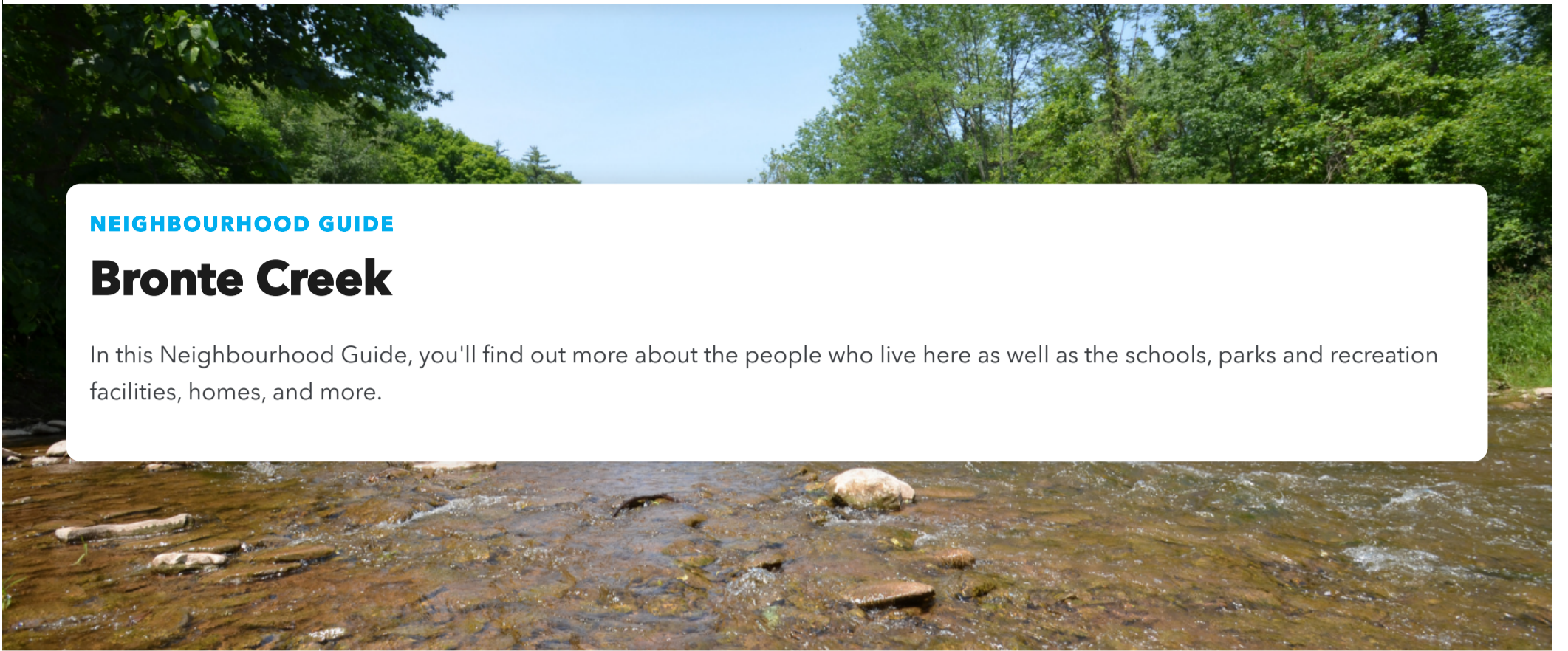

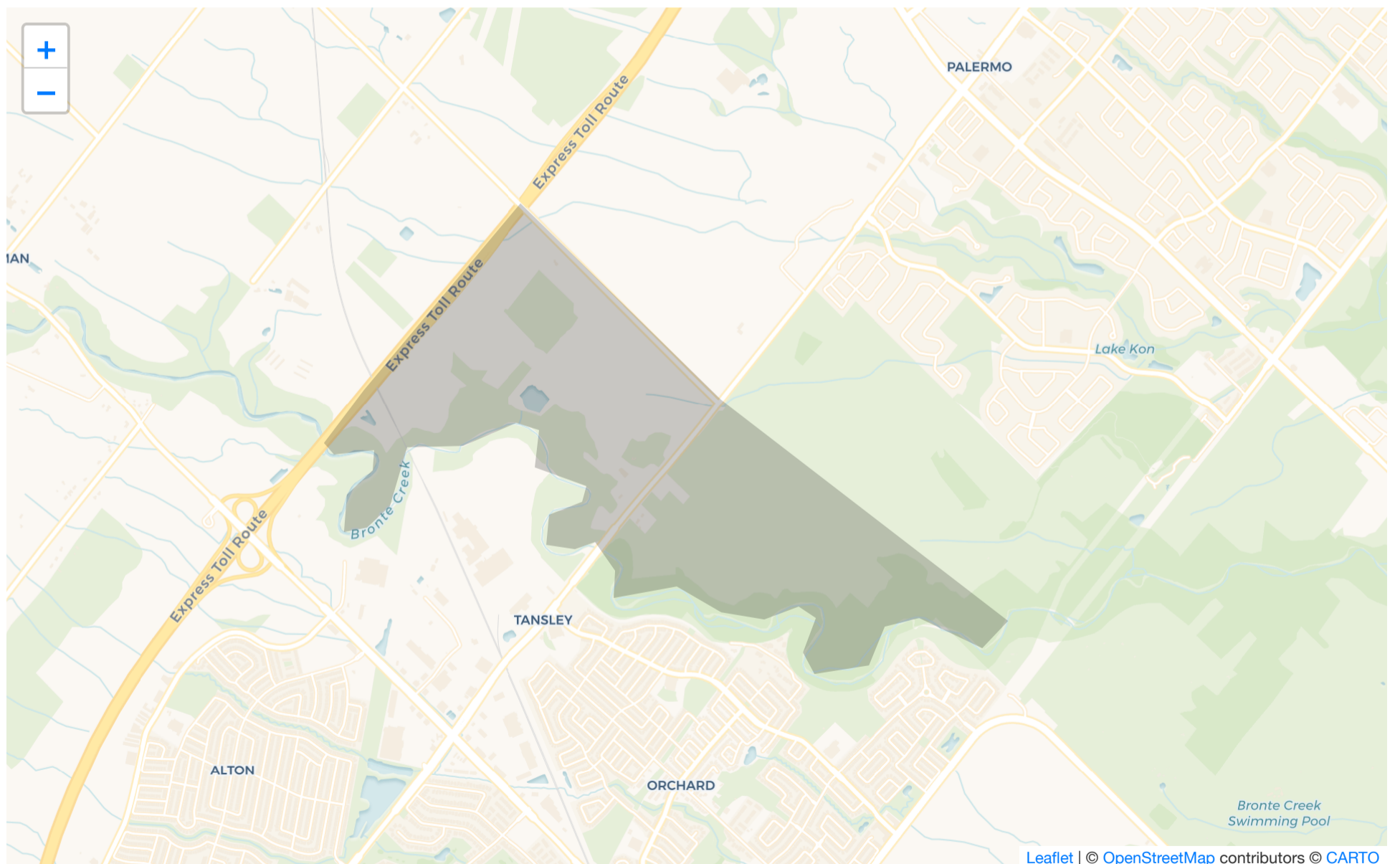


NEIGHBOURHOOD GUIDE

Bronte Creek
