




NEIGHBOURHOOD GUIDE

Bronte Meadows

In this Neighbourhood Guide, you'll find out more about the people who live here as well as the schools, parks and recreation facilities, homes, and more.



Bronte Meadows has a consistent population, and is popular with people in their 30s, people in their 40s, people in their 50s, and people in their 60s. The Bronte Meadows neighbourhood is located in southwest Milton and was constructed between 1982–1985. The neighbourhood is within walking distance of downtown, and is close to both Milton Hospital and the sports centre, which are located on the other side of Derry Rd. A commercial area lies along Bronte St. South, and the area is home to the Milton Fairgrounds. Homes in this area are mostly single-detached on fairly large lots, on streets lined with mature trees.



28% of households and 18% of households are one person living alone. People in Bronte Meadows come from 77 different ethnic origins, and 16% are first-generation immigrants, while 24% are second-generation immigrants.
