Harrison

In this Neighbourhood Guide, you'll find out more about the people who live here as well as the schools, parks and recreation facilities, homes, and more.



This neighbourhood has a dynamic population, and is popular with families with kids under 5, families with kids aged 5 to 9, families with teens, people in their 30s, and people in their 40s. The Harrison neighbourhood is in the southwest corner of Milton and includes Hawthorne Village, developed in 2008-2015. The area is close to the Niagara Escarpment, conservation areas, and farmlands, and also to a national cycling centre, and the neighbourhood itself features woodlots, large parks, trails, and bike lanes. A shopping plaza is located on Derry Rd. Housing is mainly large single-detached homes as well as townhomes.
