



Search cities, neighbourhoods, or schools



Lakeview has a consistent population, and is popular with people in their 30s, people in their 40s, people in their 50s, and people in their 60s. The Lakeview neighbourhood is located in the southeast corner of Mississauga, with Lake Ontario as its southern boundary. Most homes in Lakeview single-detached, older homes, built before the 1980s, and are in a variety of ages and architectural styles. A golf course is located in the northeast region of Lakeview, and the Etobicoke Creek forms the eastern border. A parcel of industrial land in this area is planned for development of a lakefront community of townhomes, condos, restaurants, office space, and lakefront walkways and park lands.
