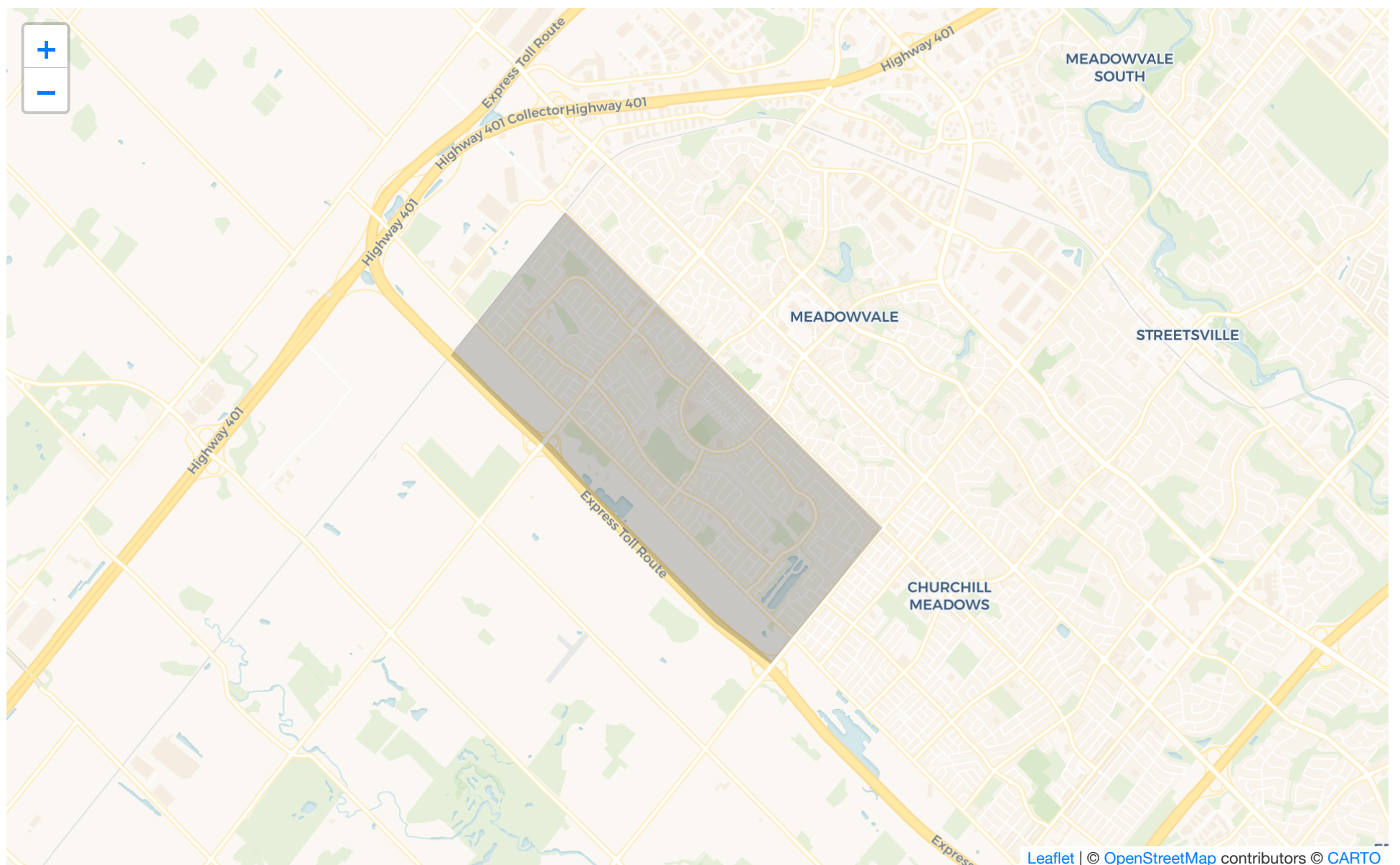


## NEIGHBOURHOOD GUIDE

# Lisgar

In this Neighbourhood Guide, you'll find out more about the people who live here as well as the schools, parks and recreation facilities, homes, and more.

Lisgar has a consistent population, and is popular with families with teens, people in their 20s, people in their 40s, and people in their 50s. Lisgar is a newer suburban neighbourhood on the western edge of Mississauga, containing mostly detached and semi-detached homes. Residents enjoy easy access to parks and recreation, as well as major highways and a GO Train station for commuters.
