



Search cities, neighbourhoods, or schools



This neighbourhood has a dynamic population, and is popular with highly educated people, recent immigrants, families with kids under 5, families with kids aged 5 to 9, families with teens, people in their 30s, and people in their 40s. Rural Oakville, north of the city core, contains a mix of new developments, farmland, parkland, and yet-to-be-developed areas. The "New Communities of Oakville" are being built in this area, including 407 West, Sixteen Hollow, Glenorchy, and Joshua's Meadows. The residential areas are planned to be large, single-detached homes, semi-detached homes, and 2- and 3-storey townhomes. These neighbourhoods are designed to be walkable communities with easy access to parks and trails as well as shopping and services.





People & Families in Rural Oakville

Families with kids make up 66% of households in this neighbourhood, while couples without children make up 17% of households and 10% of households are one person living alone. People in this neighbourhood come from 94 different ethnic origins, and 51% are first-generation immigrants, while 32% are second-generation immigrants.
