Sheridan

In this Neighbourhood Guide, you'll find out more about the people who live here as well as the schools, parks and recreation facilities, homes, and more.



This neighbourhood has a consistent population, and is popular with families with teens, people in their 20s, people in their 40s, and people in their 50s. Sheridan is a mainly residential area in southwest Mississauga. This neighbourhood features a golf course, trails, and plenty of green space, as well as amenities like cafés and restaurants, and shopping centres, including the Sheridan Centre. The northwest section is an affluent area, with a mix of housing: mostly large single-detached homes in a variety of architectural styles, on large lots, and including some estate homes. Sheridan also has condo townhomes and high-rise apartment buildings. The Sheridan Homelands area is a close, well-established community, with homes from the 1960s-1970s on tree-lined streets.



Families with kids make up 53% of households in this neighbourhood, while couples without children make up 24% of households and 17% of households are one person living alone. People in this neighbourhood come from 127 different ethnic origins, and 45% are first-generation immigrants, while 28% are second-generation immigrants.
