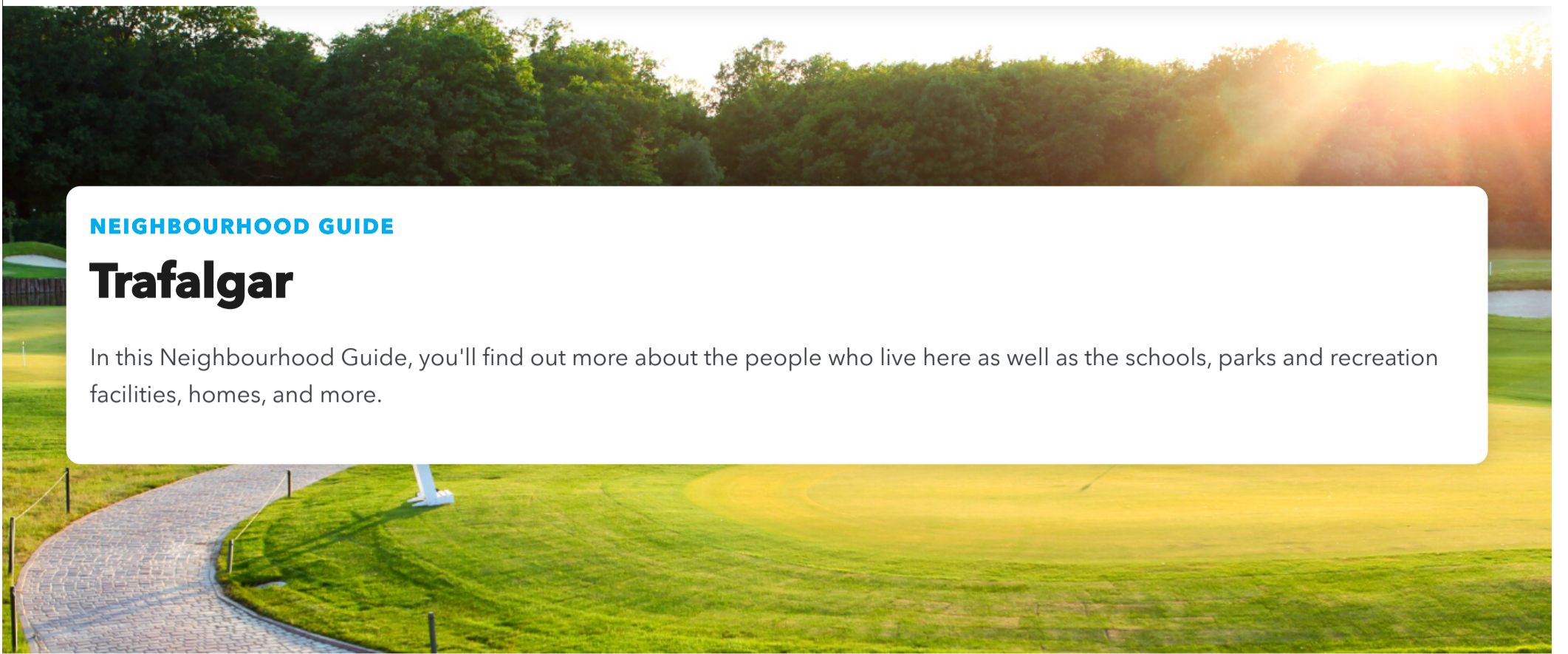

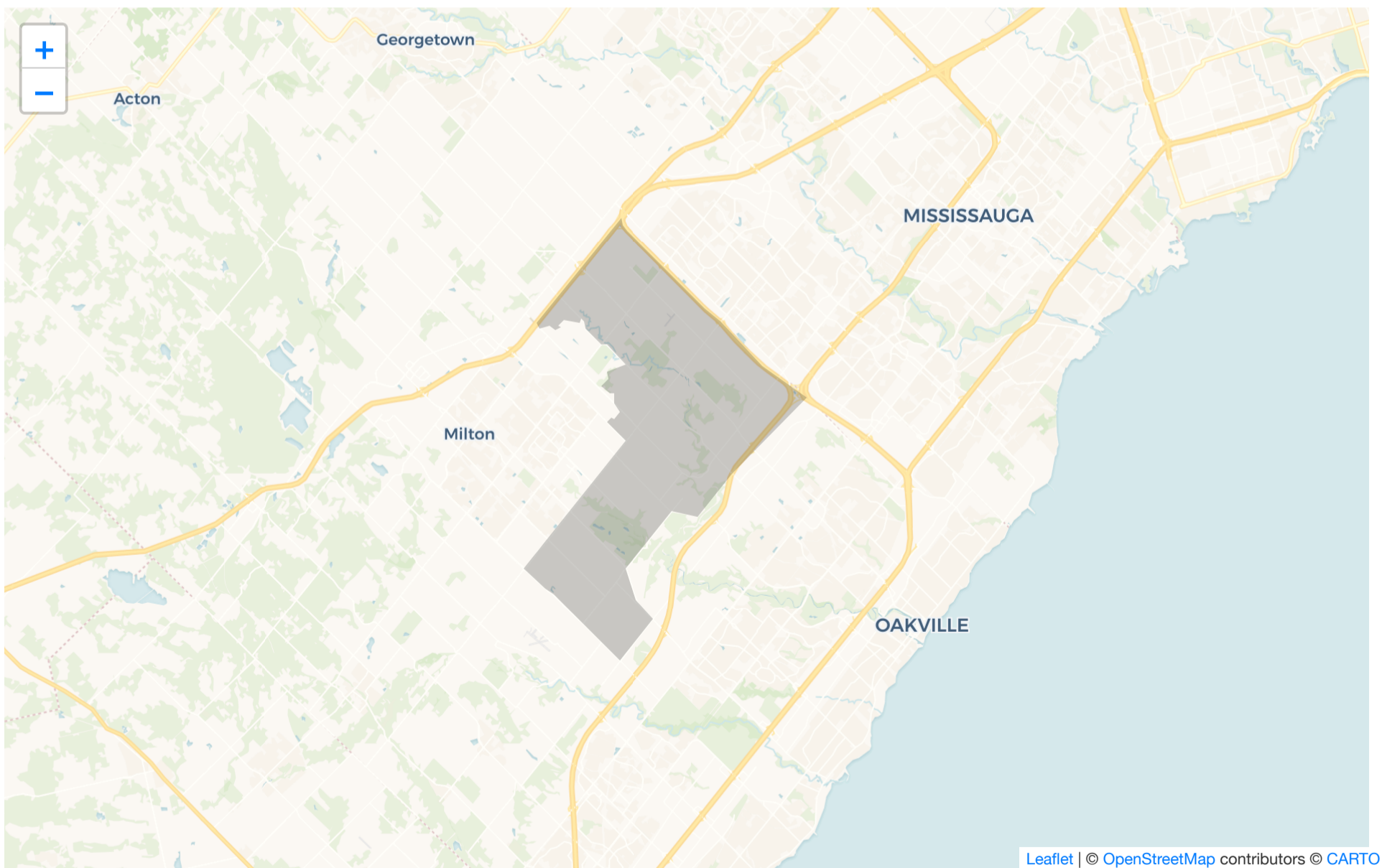

# Trafalgar
